- ★ The Scholarship Foundation was significantly impacted by the pandemic in 2020. With anticipated drops in revenue and many fundraising events canceled, your unwavering support was vital to the continued execution of our mission in the 2020-21 academic year
- ★ Your continued support enabled the Scholarship Foundation to keep our promise to leave no Marine family in-need behind, awarding a scholarship to every eligible applicant in 2020, despite a 30% increase in applications amidst a global pandemic

Helped the Foundation maintain a National top-flight Scholarship Program

★ Increasing the efficiency of data management and scholarship application processes

- ★ Improving the reporting of key performance metrics on scholarship recipients' graduation statistics, debt load, and scholarship impact
- ★ Enhancing technological capabilities to build the infrastructure needed to more efficiently and effectively process student applications reducing demand on staff and increasing the impact to more Marine and Navy Corpsmen families
- ★ Implementing new communication initiatives and platforms to improve communication with our scholarship recipients throughout the academic year


Initiated digital media outreach campaigns to elevate the Scholarship Foundation to the Nation's foremost charity supporting military families

★ Through this outreach initiative, the Foundation received a record number of scholarship applications for the 2020-21 academic year

Ensured we are continuing to meet the needs of our students, while increasing our impact — even in the face of the continually rising costs of higher education

- ★ There remains an immediate and long-term need for scholarship support to Marine families. The Scholarship Foundation will continue to pursue the goals of our strategic plan:
 - Increase our average award size to meet the projected 30% rise in the costs of post-secondary education
 - Increase the number of students who receive awards annually, with the goal of awarding 3,100 awards annually by 2027
- ★ In the 2020-21 academic year, we experienced a significant increase in scholarship applications and awarded 2,750 scholarships 400 more than the previous academic year, putting us three years ahead of planned scholarship growth
