### STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

- ★ Honorable discharge from a Marine, Navy Corpsman, Chaplain or Religious Program Specialist parent
- ★ Demonstrated financial need
- ★ GPA of at least 2.0

### SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- ★ \$10,000–\$40,000 total over four years
- ★ \$2,500 to \$10,000 per year
- ★ Average scholarship is \$3,940 per year
